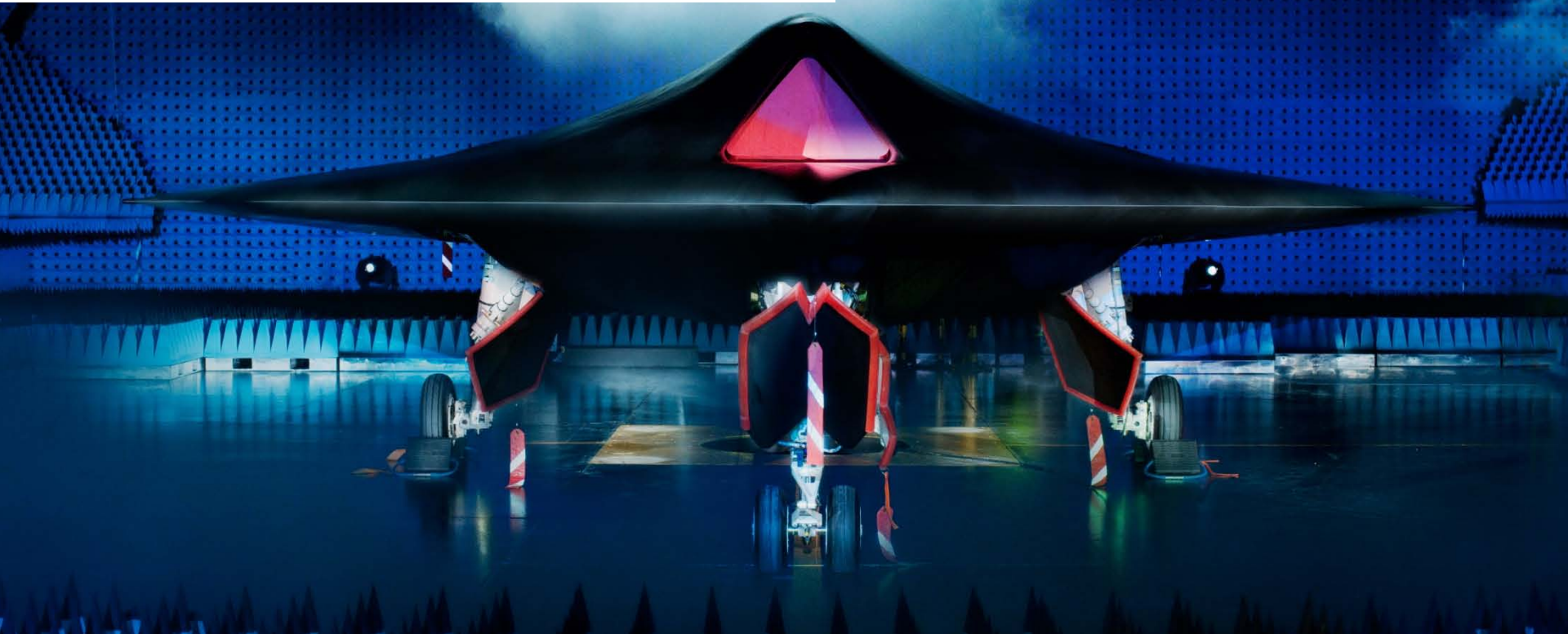


BAE Systems Engineering Taster Weeks 2019 A Brief Introduction

Overview

- In July 2019, BAE Systems Air will be hosting two residential Engineering Taster Weeks.
- This great opportunity is aimed at 16 - 18 year olds, who are considering studying a STEM subject at university or looking to apply for an apprenticeship programme.
- The weeks will be held at our Samlesbury and Warton sites in Lancashire, home to the Eurofighter Typhoon production and final assembly lines.
- Accommodation (including breakfast and evening meal) will be provided and lunch will be subsidised by BAE Systems.
- Students are only required to get themselves to and from Samlesbury at the start and end of the week. All other transport during the week will be provided.

Activities

- The challenging group project will task students to design and present an engineering solution. The week will culminate in a presentation to peers, parents and BAE Systems engineers. Prizes will be awarded to recognise team achievements.
- Have the opportunity to see the engineering facilities behind some of the most advanced military aircraft in the world and meet the people that make it happen.
- In the evenings, more informal activities will take place including a speed networking event and team building activities.
