### Future Plans

Fazakerley High School will be changing its post 16 provision from September 2017; it will be entering into joint Post 16 Provision with partner providers. Fazakerley High School will have a joint provision with Alt Valley Communiversity along with accessing some provision at our partner schools.

Current Year 11 and Year 12 students will be able to access a range of level 2 and 3 vocational courses at the Communiversity as well as accessing academic subjects at partner schools. Students will be able to select one of three pathways based on their career aspirations and attainment at GCSE.

### Courses at the Communiversity

The Communiversity has developed a range of excellent vocational courses that go from Level 1 to Level 3 in most subjects. These courses are taught at one of the Communiversity buildings and are set within an appropriate vocational setting to ensure that students experience their teaching within a working environment similar to one that they will progress to once their studies have finished. The facilities that the Communiversity can offer will enhance all students' learning in preparation for entering the world of work. The attached leaflet showcases the courses that are available at the Communiversity.

Students will follow their vocational subject for much of their timetable; students will also participate in work experience as well as having access to an extensive enrichment programme. For any student who does not achieve GCSE Grade C in Maths and/or English they will have the opportunity at the Communiversity to continue with studying Maths and/or English. Students who achieve a grade D in either Maths or English will continue to study GCSE at the Communiversity; other students who achieve a GCSE grade of E- G will follow level 2 functional skills in Maths and English.

### **Pastoral Care**

Pastoral care will always be a vital aspect within our students' education with shared responsibility for the welfare and guidance of students between Fazakerley High School and the Communiversity. Students' welfare will be monitored by relevant staff from Fazakerley High School; parents and guardians will still be able to contact staff at Fazakerley High School regarding the welfare and guidance of their sons or daughters.

### **Progress and Attainment**

The progress and attainment of all students will be monitored by staff both at the Communiversity and Fazakerley High School. Parents and Guardians will continue to receive regular progress reports throughout the year.
