Training shoes are not to be worn for school.

Moving forward, I look forward to building on the successes of Fazakerley High School and providing a welcoming, safe and stimulating learning environment for our young people, giving them the very best opportunities to achieve their full potential.

## Uniform

Through the wearing of Fazakerley High School uniform instils pride and supports positive behaviour and discipline. The wearing of a uniform helps promote a sense of belonging to the school and helps promote our ethos of being the best that you can be.

The school requires that every student should wear a uniform to maintain a high standard of appearance.

The uniform requirements for Year 7 – 11 are as follows:

### Boys

- The navy school blazer, this is compulsory
- The navy school V-neck sweater with school badge
- White shirt with school tie (new school ties available direct from the school)
- Black trousers
- Black socks
- Plain black school shoes, **NO** training shoes or labelled footwear are allowed

### Girls

- The navy school blazer, this is compulsory
- The navy school cardigan with school badge
- White open neck blouse
- Navy skirt/pinafore (sensible styles)
- White/navy socks
- Plain black shoes, **NO** training shoes or labelled footwear are allowed

**Note: No jewellery is allowed, all jewellery must be removed. Nail varnish, acrylic nails or Shellac nails and excessive makeup are not permitted and students will be asked to remove them. Strong or excessive hair colour or styles (including hair that covers a student's eyes) are not permitted.**
