



## A Guide to Uniform

Fazakerley High School has its own uniform which has been selected so that pupils feel part of the school community. Items of clothing have been chosen carefully so that they are not unduly expensive. We want our pupils to develop a sense of pride in how they are turned out, and to be proud of the school they attend. When pupils wear uniform, they are representing our community, including when they travel to and from school.

We strongly advise that all items of clothing are marked with your child's name.

### Boys uniform

- Navy school blazer with FHS logo
- Navy school V-neck sweater with FHS logo
- White shirt (short or long sleeve)
- School tie
- Black trousers
- Black socks
- Plain black polishable school shoes, without logos or accessories. Please note that boots, trainers, or fabric shoes are NOT acceptable

### Girls uniform

- Navy school blazer with FHS logo
- Navy school cardigan with FHS logo
- White blouse – open neck (reverse collar) or buttoned with school tie
- Navy skirt/pinafore (knee length - please bear this in mind when purchasing) or school trousers (black)
- White/navy socks
- Plain black polishable school shoes, without logos or accessories. Please note that boots, trainers, or fabric shoes are NOT acceptable

### Hair and Make Up

Pupils are expected to wear hair in a neat and acceptable style, one colour and natural in appearance. Hair styles (including shaved heads), judged to be extreme by the Headteacher, are not permitted. Make up, including nail varnish, false nails, false eyelashes or other such accessories are not permitted. Large hair fashion accessories are not to be worn. Pupils who do not conform to the policy will be sanctioned in line with the Behaviour Policy. We ask, as always, for parents support in this matter in order to equip our pupils for later life and the expectations they will face in the 'World of Work'.

### Jewellery

Watches may be worn, and one pair of small studs **in the earlobe only**. No other jewellery or body/facial piercings are to be worn. This is to avoid the potential risk of accidental damage from the wearing of such items. It is not acceptable to wear plasters over piercings, and pupils will be asked to remove them. Again, we ask for your support in this matter.

**The Headteacher reserves the right to make the final decision on what is or is not appropriate.**

### Mobile phones

We advise that pupils do not bring phones into School. However, we also recognise the need for safety of travel to and from School. Any phones brought into school, should be switched off as students enter the premises. Pupils will be reminded as they enter the school each day to ensure phones are placed in lockers. Please do not

seek to contact your child during the school day on their phone; any communication through the day should be made via the appropriate PPL for their year group. We will not be using lockers during "Covid" times.
